Chapter House Renovations Committee Donor Recognition Program & Naming Rights

This document outlines naming opportunities for alumni and how donors will be recognized

Recognition

All alumni who make a donation to the renovations campaign will be recognized as follows:

- On a perpetual plaque located in the entrance of the house (by gift level)
- On the Skullumni and Renovations Committee's website
- In the Skullumni newsletter
- By a thank you card from the Renovations Committee and undergraduates
- By a thank you card from the university (if donation is made through them)

Alumni who make larger donations of \$5,000 or more will also be recognized by:

- Having the opportunity to see the completed renovations prior to the official ribbon-cutting ceremony (tentatively Homecoming 2011)
- Receiving special recognition and thanks at the Renovations Ribbon-Cutting Banquet (tentatively Homecoming 2011)
- Having the opportunity to name a room in the newly renovated house

All alumni who donate will also have the lifelong knowledge that their donation helped Phi Kap endure and prosper at the University of Maine!

Perpetual Plaque at the Chapter House

Alumni will be listed on the perpetual plaque by the following donation levels:

- \$50,000+: OEHP Society Club
- \$25,000 - \$49,999: Founder's Club
- \$10,000 - \$24,999: Alpha's Club
- \$7,500 - \$9,999: Platinum Skull Club
- \$5,000 - \$7,499: Diamond Skull Club
- \$2,500 - \$4,999: Golden Skull Club
- \$1,000 - \$2,499: Silver Skull Club
- \$500 - \$999: Black & Gold Club
- Less than \$500: Chrysanthemum Club

In addition, the following information will be inscribed on the plaque:

- Name of Top Donor
- Class that Donated the Most
- Top 10 Donor Classes
- Class that Donated the Most Per Capita
- Top 10 Donor Classes Per Capita
- Decade that Donated the Most
- Decade that Donated the Most Per Capita

Naming Opportunities

As noted above, alumni who make larger donations will have the ability to name a room in the newly renovated chapter house. These names may be made after the alumnus himself or in honor of a fellow brother (or brothers) and will appear next to the door inscribed on a plaque. The following rooms are available for naming:

Residential Rooms

Alumni will have the opportunity to name one of the 19 residential rooms* based on the following table:

Floor	Number of Rooms	Cost to Name
1 st	1 (live-in advisor)	\$5,000
2 nd	10	\$10,000
3 rd	8	\$5,000

*In instances where multiple donations are received for a room naming, priority will be given to the first alumnus to make their donation in full. Certain accommodations may be possible (such as dual named rooms) but are not guaranteed so please first inquire with the Renovations Committee

Common Rooms

Alumni will have the opportunity to name one of the five (5) other rooms in the house based on the following table:

Floor	Room Description	How Named
1 st	Dining Room	3 of 4 will be named for individuals who make the top donations. Remaining room named for class that makes the largest total combined donation (minimum 2 donors).
1 st	Library/Study Room	
1 st	Living Room	
1 st	Kitchen	
2 nd	Bathroom	Named for the class(es) with more than one living alumnus

		that gives \$0 combined (plaques for each class above toilets & sinks)
3 rd	Study Area	Named for the class that donates the most per capita (minimum 2 donors)
Outside	Sauna	\$10,000 (or more) donation

The Chapter Room will NOT be named out of respect for equality of the entire Brotherhood

Basement

Although the basement area will not be renovated, alumni will be given naming rights to the following areas:

Room Description	Cost to Name
(Former) Bar	\$5,000
(Former) Beer Die Area	\$5,000
Dance Floor Area	\$3,600
Old Kitchen Area (New Weight Room?)	\$3,600
